COURSE CONTENT

Define Coaching Conversations

Helping participants shift from a mindset of telling, problem solving and giving advice, to enabling others to have ownership of their challenges and take responsibility for their actions. This involves using an 'ask not tell' approach.

Listening Skills

Learning the art of listening demonstrates to your team, that you are respectful, openminded and genuinely paying attention to their needs. Active listening skills can help you delve into issues at a much deeper level – revealing beliefs, values and limiting assumptions that may be key to unlocking their potential.

GROW Model

This coaching framework is widely used by leaders in meetings and everyday conversations to unlock potential and possibilities, resulting in problem solving, goal setting and performance improvement.

Coaching the Team

Introducing the concept of team coaching will assist those who find themselves working regularly with group of managers or executives. Learning the core skills of team coaching will allow participants to give members of their group the opportunity to stretch beyond their current abilities.

Coach Practice and Feedback with Course Practice Tutors

Through a process of practice and feedback from tutors and peers and supervisors, participants will develop a range of coaching skills and an understanding of coaching cultures in organisations.



Action Learning

Action Learning will form part of the programme to give participants an opportunity to work in small groups on real problems, taking action, and learning as individuals, as a team, and as an organisation. This learning method helps individuals to develop creative, flexible and successful strategies to workplace problems.

Structure

The course will be delivered over three consecutive days. This course provides a special opportunity to hone your real-time coaching skills.
