A warm welcome to both: Ireland and also to the UCD Smurfit School for all new students joining us in the 2025-26 academic year.





Emails (monthly) from the School Office team to students who have accepted an offer (you will also receive emails from other central UCD offices like Registry or UCD Global).


Webpage for new incoming students with a lot of info about starting your studies. Link is provided in the monthly emails aimed at students who have accepted their offer.


<u>Programme Orientation</u> - a mandatory session with your classmates and programme director & programme manager, followed by a social event (location: Blackrock campus)
